Two community car schemes in East Northamptonshire are working together to provide community transport. The two organisations are registered local Charities.

The voluntary car scheme is primarily for essential medical appointments, doctor, dentist, optician, consultant and any other medical professional. You can also use the service to visit family and friends who are in hospital or in residential care.

How do you use the Service?

1. Simply contact your local organisation as soon as you have an appointment. We would prefer 48 hours notice prior to your appointment.
2. We require the details of your journey – date and time of the appointment and if you have any other requirements such as wheelchair adapted vehicle
3. You will be told the cost of your journey
4. On the day of your appointment one of our volunteer drivers will pick you up at your home

Who is Eligible for the service?

Anyone who finds public transport unsuitable or unavailable, and cannot afford the alternative of taxis. The service is also available to disabled people with wheelchairs, zimmer frames or other walking aids

Who uses the service?

It is available to everyone living in the East Northamptonshire Area. Children under 16 years old are welcome as long as an adult accompanies them

Who will drive you?

Local volunteer drivers who are willing to use their own car and give up their free time to help the community
